



Thierry APOTEKER, Chairman, TAC ECONOMICS



Thierry Apoteker graduated from the top French school of management (HEC Paris) and obtained a PhD in monetary economics from the University of Paris Dauphine. He started as a junior economist in a French think tank (BIPE.) and then moved to Banque Indosuez (now Crédit Agricole Corporate & Investment Bank, CACIB) where he set up the country risk division before becoming the bank's Chief Economist and Head of the Research Department.

Thierry Apoteker left the bank in the early 90s to create the first private “research boutique” in continental Europe, which transformed into TAC ECONOMICS over the years: it is now a fully independent research group providing economic, financial and strategic research and advisory services to large corporations, governments and multilateral institutions organization worldwide. Thierry is the founding Chairman of the company and continues to lead its research drive and to advise senior executives at multinational companies and international organizations on international strategies and risk mitigation policies.

Thierry Apoteker is involved in many academic activities, including a four-year position as an Associate Professor of Economy at the University of Rennes (France), and a current position of Lecturer at Master level at HEC Paris in the field of Sustainable Development and Systemic Shocks. Thierry is a frequent participant in international conferences on economic, financial and risk issues and a regular contributor to European and Asian economic and financial media.
